

Instructions for the Pure range of tables

Handling:

It is important to handle the table top with care and not subject the edges to heavy loads once the packing has been removed.

Product description:

The table top is a handmade product, cast in fibre concrete. Fibre concrete is a mixture of cement and quartz sand to which fibreglass has been added. This combination produces a very light, strong table top with a contemporary, rustic appearance. As the table tops are cast and finished individually, each one is unique. The table top may have small air holes from the casting process, while the corners and edges are bent manually, which may produce natural variations in appearance. This does not affect the quality of the table.

The frame is made from high-grade stainless steel.

Assembly:

The table is designed in such a way that the table top does not have to be secured, but simply is placed on top of the frame. The frame has a rubber rim to prevent the table top from moving.

Daily use:

The fibre-concrete table top has been treated with a special impregnation, which does not seal the surface though. This means that the surface of the fibre concrete is still susceptible to stains (grease and red wine, for example). It is therefore advisable to wipe the table top immediately after spills with a damp cloth and dishwashing detergent. Make sure to work some detergent carefully down into the surface. Let the detergent sit for a few minutes to obtain a maximum effect. The table top may still show faint signs of the stain afterwards, but these will gradually fade or disappear completely.

The table top should not be exposed to the effects of acid or acidic products for any length of time. Hot items should not be placed directly on the table. Moving/pulling items with a rough underside across the table may cause scratching.

The table top can be cleaned on a daily basis with a damp cloth and a little pH-neutral cleaner or dishwashing detergent (pH 7+). When deep cleansing the surface, it is important to do it gently.

Regular maintenance:

The impregnation of the table top will, depending on climate and usage, hold for 2-3 years. If the table is covered during fall/winter, the protection is prolonged considerably. If the top needs to be treated anew, it must first be cleaned with a pH-neutral (7+) cleaner. The top can now be treated with a suitable impregnation fluid, i.e. Aquamix.

In the event of deep scratches or indentations in the table top, the damaged area should be re-impregnated using the provided Aqua-Mix Sealer.

Although the frame is made from stainless steel, tarnishing can occur in the form of flash rust. This can be removed using a stainless steel polisher. The frame can be protected against tarnishing by wiping it with acid-free oil at least twice a year.

Winter storage:

The table can be left outside all year round. However, this may result in algae having to be cleaned off, while increasing the chances of rings/marks being made by objects left on the table. It is therefore advisable to store the table under a cover or in a garage/carport over the winter.
