Cane-line TEAK/Hularo®

The tabletop comes untreated. This means that the teak will acquire a silver grey patina if it is not treated prior to use and then at regular intervals as required. If the tabletop is treated with a suitable teak oil, the wood will acquire a darker glow, which can be preserved by treating the wood with teak oil. The frequency of the applications will depend on the climate and whether the table is under cover, for example. As a rule of thumb, it is a good idea to oil the tabletop at least once a year.

If the teak tabletop turns silver grey or black, a suitable teak cleaner can be used. Once the table has been treated with teak cleaner and washed thoroughly with water, it should be allowed to dry. When it is completely dry, oil can be applied. If the tabletop has been left for a long time and acquired a patina, it may have to be rubbed down prior to cleaning.
